



School Uniform Policy

APPEARANCE & UNIFORM – STUDENT DRESS CODE

MIS students wear their uniform with pride and in promoting this, adherence to school uniform regulations and the highest possible standards of appearance are expected.

- (a) **Girls Uniform** Navy blue trousers, white blouse and navy blue tabard
- (b) **Boys Uniform** Omani:- National dress - grey dishdasha, ma'ssar or kumma
Other:- Navy blue trousers, white shirt.
- (c) **Footwear**
As most of the flooring in the main school is marble, it is highly recommended that students wear rubber-soled shoes.
Girls: Dark coloured, closed-in shoes [or trainers] with rubber soles.
Boys: Dark coloured, closed-in shoes [or trainers] with rubber soles.
For Omani boys in Grade 10, 11 and 12 only, sandals are accepted.
- (d) **Sportswear - P.E.**
A special P.E. kit is available for purchase at the school and this **MUST** be worn on all occasions required
- (e) **Aprons and Other Laboratory Safety-Wear**
To protect clothes, eyes, hands, etc., during cooking, art/drama lessons etc. and laboratory periods, aprons and other safety-wear will be provided and must be worn.
- (f) **Name Tapes/Marking**
It is advisable for all clothing to be clearly marked either in indelible ink or by personal name tapes.
- (g) **Make-Up**
Nail varnish and make-up must not be worn.
- (h) **Hair**
In the interest of safety, hair (of both girls & boys) should be kept neat in style and brushed well off the face. Long hair is to be tied back at all times and especially during craft, cooking, science and PE lessons. Exaggerated hair styles will be discussed with parents.
- (i) **Jewelry**
Students may wear a watch (to be given to P.E. staff during P.E. lessons if required), and one other item of discreet neckwear. Girls with pierced ears may wear small stud/sleeper earrings. All other pierced jewelry is not accepted. The school is not responsible for any jewelry items which may be misplaced or lost at school.
